### **Times Tables Rockstars**

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In preparation for the Year 4 Multiplication Check, we will be focusing on practising our times tables regularly at school. This will not only help the children feel more confident for the upcoming Multiplication Check later in the year, but it will also help them feel more confident in all areas of the maths curriculum. As part of Year 4's homework, your child should be logging on to Times Tables Rockstars at least three times a week for 5-10 minutes. Their login details will be in the front of their homework book.

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# **Homework and Home Reading**

Children need to continue to read at home. This is imperative to help improve their reading stamina and fluency. It should be enjoyable and therefore, if they read books that they have selected independently, or news articles that they have found interesting, then we want to hear about it. For their homework, children are expected to read for a minimum of 5 minutes every day with their reading logbook being signed by an adult. Children should bring their reading logbook to school every day — it will be checked and signed by a teacher every Thursday.

Extra homework challenges will be sent home in a homework book. These are to last the term and are to be completed at your pace. If your child wishes to bring these into school to show an adult, they are welcome to do so.

### **Music lessons**

Every Thursday, Mr Higley from Hull Music Service will deliver the children's music lessons when they will be learning how to play the glockenspiel. This will be for the duration of Year 4 and at the end of the year, the children will be invited to participate in a concert showcase to perform the songs they have learned in their music lessons alongside lots of other schools in the city. This is an incredibly exciting opportunity!
